Venue & Transportation

Conference Venue: Kadir Has University Cibali Campus

The Opening and Closing Ceremonies will be held in the **D Büyük Salon** (D Big Hall). All committee sessions will take place in the designated lecture halls across the campus.

How to Get Here

The campus is highly accessible via Istanbul's public transportation network. Here are the best ways to reach the university:

- **By Tram (T5):** Take the T5 tram line and disembark at the Cibali station. The campus is directly across the street.
- **By Metro & Tram (M2 + T5):** Take the M2 Metro line to the Haliç station. From there, transfer to the T5 tram line and ride it to the Cibali station.
- **By Bus:** Take any bus route that stops at the Unkapanı station. From Unkapanı, it is a short 5-minute walk to the university.

Campus Navigation: Our administrative team will be stationed at the entrance to guide you to the registration desks and D Büyük Salon upon arrival.

Attendance Policy

Commitment to your committee is essential for a successful conference. Please note the following strict attendance rules:

- If a delegate is absent for **2 sessions**, no awards will be granted to them.
- If a delegate is absent for **3 or more sessions**, they will not receive a participation certificate.

Plagiarism & AI Policy

At HASMUN'26, academic integrity is of the utmost importance. Plagiarism in any form is strictly prohibited. Delegates are expected to submit entirely original work for all conference documents.

The use of pre-written resolutions, plagiarized clauses from previous conferences, or **any AI-generated content is strictly forbidden**. This includes using AI tools for writing speeches, drafting clauses, or producing position papers. All submitted documents will be subjected to rigorous plagiarism and AI-detection scans. Any delegate found to have violated this policy will face immediate disciplinary action by the Secretariat, which may include the invalidation of their documents, disqualification from all awards, or expulsion from the conference.

Rules of Procedure: Cheat Sheet

A quick reference guide to the essential points and motions used during HASMUN formal sessions.

1. Points

POINT	PURPOSE	INTERRUPT?
Personal Privilege	Used when experiencing personal discomfort (e.g., room temperature, unable to hear the speaker).	YES (Audibility)
Order	Used to point out an instance of improper parliamentary procedure by the Chair or another delegate.	YES
Parliamentary Inquiry	Used to ask the Chair board a question regarding the rules of procedure.	NO
Information	Used to ask the speaker a question regarding their statement (after they finish speaking).	NO

2. Essential Motions

MOTION	PURPOSE	VOTE
Moderated Caucus	Suspends the Speakers' List for a rapid debate on a specific sub-topic. Must specify total time & speaker time.	Simple
Unmoderated Caucus	Informal time for lobbying, networking, and drafting resolutions. Must specify total time.	Simple
Closure of Debate	Ends all debate on the current topic/document and moves the committee immediately into voting procedure.	2/3rds

Suspend the Meeting	Pauses all committee functions until the next scheduled session (e.g., for coffee or lunch breaks).	Simple
Roll Call Voting	Requests that the committee votes country-by-country instead of raising placards.	Simple
Adjournment of the meeting	Suspend all Committee functions for the duration of the Conference.	Simple

Yielding Your Time

During the General Speakers' List, if you finish early, you must yield: 1) To the Chair (moves to the next speaker), 2) To another Delegate, or 3) To Questions.

Electronics Policy

Electronic devices (phones, laptops, tablets) are strictly prohibited during formal sessions. They may ONLY be used during Unmoderated Caucuses for drafting resolutions.

Dress Code Policy

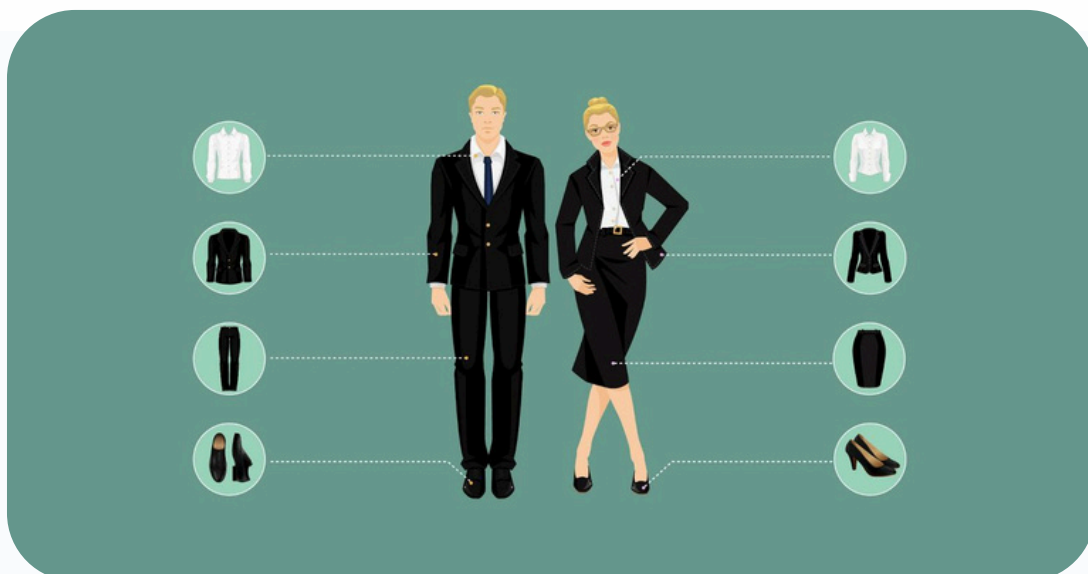
As Model UN simulates real diplomatic proceedings, all participants are expected to maintain a high standard of professionalism in their attire. Western Business Attire (WBA) is mandatory for all committee sessions and ceremonies.

Permitted Attire

- Matching suits (jacket and trousers/skirts).
- Dress shirts with ties or bow ties.
- Business dresses or blouses. **For female delegates, all dresses and skirts must be below the knee.**
- Professional dress shoes, flats, or low heels.
- Sneakers are allowed, provided they are leather and strictly solid white or solid black in color.

Strictly Prohibited

- Non-leather sneakers, brightly colored sneakers, running shoes, or casual boots.
- Skirts or dresses above the knee.
- Jeans, sweatpants, or athletic wear.
- T-shirts or polo shirts.



Note: The Secretariat reserves the right to issue warnings or excuse delegates from sessions for major dress code violations.
